INSTALLATION

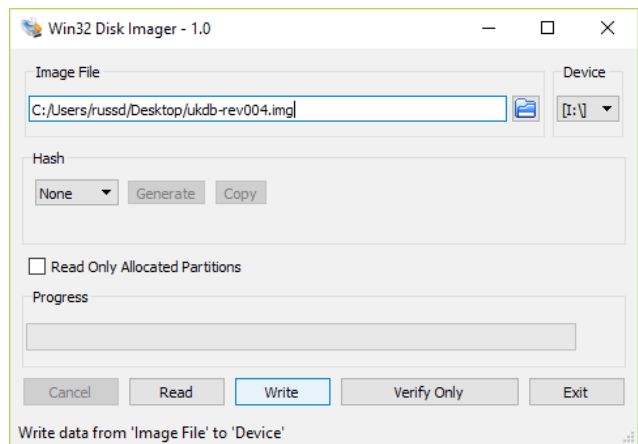
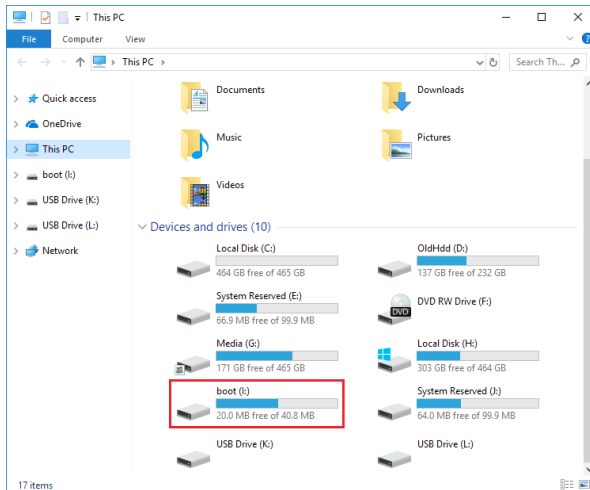
If the sd card has become corrupt or accidentally formatted the raw .img can be reinstalled using the following steps.

(Step1) Download [win32DiskImager](#)

(Step2) Download new [SD Card image](#) and unzip it. So you are left with a .img file.

(Step3) Plug your sd card into the computer.

(Step4) Run win32diskimager and selected the .img file. Select the drive letter your sd card "boot" drive appears under (usually "I")



(Step5) Press "Write" to start the writing process. This usually takes around 10 minutes to complete.

(Step6) Once complete you will need to set your WiFi credentials again.

Note: Ignore any warning messages (press OK).
